Year-End Statistics

Hatzolah of Passaic/Clifton EMS has been servicing the community for a little over a year and we would like to update the community on some of the first year's statistics.

Total Calls (since inception): 448
Transports to Hospitals: 340
Percentage of Hospital Transports: 76%
First Responders: 21
Dispatchers: 13

Most of the emergencies that we responded to were for traumas (ranging from a simple cut to a serious head injury) and medical emergencies (chest pain, strokes, difficulty breathing). We responded to numerous Motor Vehicle Accidents, pedestrians struck and missing persons. We were even fortunate enough to help deliver two beautiful babies!

During the year we have had many Halacha classes given by the Rabbonim and others, with numerous Shiurim planned for the coming year.

Additionally, we have had numerous Continuing Education classes with Dr. Rosen, our Medical Director, and with other vendors authorized by the State, including classes on EMS Documentation, use of Epinephrine for victims of allergic reactions and how to conduct searches for missing persons.

Our Dispatchers have also received regular refreshers

and classes to make sure they are kept up to date.

We are proud to have participated in the health and well being of the Passaic – Clifton community in so many ways. We were fortunate to collaborate with the Bikur Cholim in producing the first ever Health and Safety Fair, hosting health lectures and more.

We are thankful that the Rabbonim chose Hatzolah to be the recipient of this year's Yom Kippur and Shmini Atzeres appeals.

We look forward to another successful year of providing quality emergency medical service, health and safety education and more.
